- Activities or sports may be withdrawn if participant numbers fail to meet established minimums.

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Art

Battle of the Books

America's Battle of the Books is a reading incentive program for students in 5th and 6th grades. They read books and come together to demonstrate their abilities and to test their knowledge of the books they've read. The student competitions are similar to the TV series *Family Feud* or *Whiz Kids* styles of competitions. We will be meeting in the LS Learning Commons one afternoon after school to read the books and test comprehension in preparation for the battle scheduled for April 19, 2024.

Book Bowl

Book Bowl is a highly regarded reading competition in Europe and across North America. For this competition, 12 books are carefully chosen and divided among three teams of avid readers. Each team focuses on reading and delving deeply into four books (though they are encouraged to explore all 12 and assist their peers). The after-school activity aims to motivate readers to stay on track, engage in thorough discussions about the books, and hone the skills required for the final competition. During the competition, the teams participate in six rounds of trivia and questioning, each with a different theme. Team members collaborate to provide the best answers in the shortest time possible.

Cascais Routes

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Dancesport

Calling all upper school students to join the Dancesport activity, where we focus on Ballroom (Waltz, Tango, Slow Foxtrot, Viennese Waltz, and Quickstep) and Latin American Dances (Samba, Cha Cha, Rumba, Paso Doble, and Jive). This activity is for those who want to learn socially or potentially compete; no experience needed.

ELC Board Games

In judo, students learn the technique of self-defense and the concept of leverage using your body weight and angles.

Kendo

Kendo is a traditional Japanese martial art, descended from the swordsmanship techniques used by the samurai, that uses bamboo swords (shinai) and protective armor (bogu). The goal is to strike the opponent with the bamboo sword on certain parts of the armor, therefore some call it "Japanese fencing". We will start at TASIS Portugal with a beginners' course during which the students can wear their regular PE uniform (TASIS Portugal will provide the bamboo swords). The students will hit the teacher, but they will not be receiving any strikes, therefore will not wear a protective armor themselves. Besides being a fun and healthy activity, Kendo teaches students discipline, respect, self-confidence, and resilience. The instructor (sensei) is Rogier van Bijnen, a TASIS Portugal parent who has practiced kendo since 1992, is 5th dan in Kendo and former Dutch champion, and represented the Netherlands in multiple World Championships.

Lego Club

Fun and enriching activities that develop teamwork and problem solving through guided Lego projects. Opportunities for free play and creativity.

Library Club

Is your child passionate about organization? Do they find joy in creating neat and tidy spaces? If so, the Library Club is the perfect fit for them! 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Mindfulness & Yoga

Mindfulness activities are a wonderful way to help children learn to self-regulate, calm, and soothe. It aims to offer students a space of relaxation and attention training. The objective is to help children develop skills such as focusing solely on one task at a time, working collaboratively, following instructions, and speaking and listening. Mindfulness has countless benefits to adults and children alike, ranging from developing emotional control to improving problem-solving skills.

Mini Football

Learn football in a fun environment. Our highly experienced coach will stimulate imagination and aid early development skills such as learning colors and numbers, following instructions, and playing as a team.

Mini Tennis

Mini tennis provides children with the perfect opportunity to learn the fundamentals of tennis at an early age. Designed for children aged between 4 and 10, mini tennis utilizes smaller courts, nets, and rackets, as well as lower-bouncing tennis balls to develop vital tennis skills and techniques. **This is a paid club (€220.00 for the term).**

MUN (Model United Nations)

(Middle School, 6-8)

If your child is in grades 6, 7, or 8 and is interested in global issues, public speaking, and debating, the TASIS Middle School Model United Nations (MUN) is for them. MUNs are simulations of the real United Nations, where participants represent different countries to discuss and debate current and historical global issues such as the environment, human rights, and international cooperation. At TASIS MUN, participants will have the opportunity to practice speaking, research, and thinking skills, and also to become confident with MUN conference rules and procedures. During the academic year, students will be offered the opportunity to participate in external MUN conferences held in the Lisbon area.

MUN (High School, 9-10)

If your child is in grades 9 or 10 and is interested in global issues, public speaking, and debating, the TASIS Middle School Model United Nations (MUN) is for them. MUNs are simulations of the real United Nations, where participants represent different countries to discuss and debate current and historical global issues such as the environment, human rights, and international cooperation. At TASIS MUN, participants will have the opportunity to practice speaking, research, and thinking skills, and also to become confident with MUN conference rules and procedures. During the academic year, students will be offered the opportunity to participate in external MUN conferences held in the Lisbon area.

Padel

Padel is a racquet sport that combines the elements of tennis, squash, and badminton. Extremely fun, social, and accessible for all, padel is only played in doubles and is practiced

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outdoors as much as indoors. The students will be transported by the School to the off-site location, BLUE Padel Korts, and pick-up must be at the venue at 17:00. The address is *R. da Tapada Nova, 2710-001 Sintra*. **This is a paid club and includes transport to the venue (€ 232.00 for the term).**

Photography Club

Students explore photography and enhance their creative expression. They learn simple photo techniques like symmetry, framing, and scale. Then they put those tips into action by taking pictures in and around the school.

Portuguese Club (beginner)

This club is like a playgroup for children who want to acquire Portuguese as a foreign language through fun and games. The goal is to develop language communication skills in a fun way, through games, songs, storybooks, and leisure.

Robotics/Coding

Would you like your child to join this after-school activity focused on designing and building robots that can solve challenges and achieve goals? Students will utilize sensors to navigate and address problems. They will also have the opportunity to compete against other teams to determine who can build and program the most effective robots.

Rugby

Seasoned tag rugby players who are ready to take their game to the next level are welcome to our advanced club, kicking it up a notch with **full contact** rugby. This isn't a beginner's club; it's for those who've already felt the thrill of tag rugby and are ready for more. They dive into the intensity of full-contact play, master the art of tackles, and experience the true grit of rugby. Please note that gum shields are mandatory.

Speech and Debate

This provides Upper School students with an opportunity to hone their public speaking skills. Participants will collaborate to refine their speeches for TASIS Speaks, engage in debate tournaments, and conquer nervousness. Topics encompass a wide range, including politics, current events, entertainment, and more.

Speed Stacking

Speed stacking is both an individual and team sport that involves stacking nine or 12 specially designed cups in pre-determined sequences as fast as you can. The benefits include hand-eye and bilateral coordination, body-brain connections, distribution of practice, and fitness.

Student News – Investigate the World

Students who wish to roam the school premises, posing questions to teachers, staff, and fellow students, and capturing moments through photographs, will have the opportunity to conduct interviews, write, and proofread stories about their school, staff, and community.

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Subsequently, they can compile these materials into a captivating and informative newspaper featuring their own articles. This is an ideal endeavor for upper school students aiming to make a positive impression on prospective universities. The role of a staff newspaper reporter (and photographer) is challenging – and impressive.

Surfing

The Hooked Surf School offers group surf lessons, kids surf club, surfboard, and wetsuit hire. The choice of different beach breaks, consistent waves, and natural beauty add to the experience of learning to surf in a safe, fun, and friendly environment. The surf school will transport the students to the location, which can vary between either *Carcavelos* or *Guincho* beach (depending on the waves), and pick-up must be at the location at 18:00. **This is a paid activity invoiced directly by the surf school at €20 per lesson.**

Taekwondo

Regardless of age and gender, every child's self-esteem can benefit from learning the basics of self-defense in a fun and stimulating environment. Taekwondo is a Korean martial art known for the gracefulness of its movements. At TASIS, we are privileged that Taekwondo is taught twice a week by Ana Paula Silva, 6th Dan, the country's highest ranked female practitioner, with over 30 years' teaching experience. Her classes are extremely high-energy and use games and other fun activities to develop courtesy, self-control, discipline, and correct movement.

Tag Rugby

Tag rugby teaches the fundamentals of the game in a safe environment and allows children to get a feel for the game. It is a fun, fast-moving, non-contact game, ideal for children. Each player wears a tag belt with Velcro tags attached to them. Attacking players must dodge defenders attempting to "tag" them by pulling the Velcro tag from the player with the ball.

Tennis

Hand-eye coordination, motor control, ball tracking, and striking skills while building balance, foot speed, strength, fitness, agility, and flexibility. The students will be transported by the School to Beloura Tennis Academy, and pick-up must be at the venue at 17:00. The address is *Alameda da Beloura 5, 2710-694, Sintra*. **This is a paid club and includes transport to the venue (€254.00 for the term).**

The Inventors

Students will embark on a weekly journey where each session unveils a new realm of creative superpowers. They will unleash their imagination while crafting a unique board game, diving into the world of electronic synthesizers, or delving into the artistry of stop-motion filmmaking. These engaging programs are designed to ignite their creativity, offering a spectrum of hands-on experiences that transform each moment into a discovery of their limitless creative potential. **This is a paid club (€165.00 for the term).**

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Tile Painting

Portugal is known for its beautiful hand-painted *azulejos* (tiles). Students attending will have fun learning tile painting techniques, like making tracings and transferring designs. In addition to painting tiles, they will have some special ceramic projects like plates, ornaments, and sardines to paint. Some mosaic work using broken tiles to decorate a flowerpot, photo frame, or mirror will also be included. By the end of the school year, a four-tile tray with a geometric design will be completed. **This is a paid club (€235.00 for the term).**

Volleyball

This fast-paced team sport is not just a game; it's an exhilarating blend of strategy, teamwork, and heart-pounding action. Students learn to master precise passes, unleash powerful spikes, and experience the electric energy of intense rallies. Whether they're seasoned players or new to the game, volleyball promises an unforgettable journey of skill-building, camaraderie, and non-stop fun.

Yoga

The yoga club aims to teach students about relaxation, meditation, and inner peace while having fun. Namaste!

Zumba

This is a super fun fitness class that combines Latin rhythms and easy to follow moves. It is inspired by Latin dance and music and uses a variety of styles in the routines, including cumbia, merengue, salsa, reggaeton, mambo, rumba, flamenco, samba, and hip-hop.
